REQUIREMENTS: Acceptance is based on audition, instrumentation needs for chamber ensembles (trios, quartets, quintets), and readiness for small ensemble playing. Audition information will be sent after April 15th.

Professional chamber musicians and CMS faculty well experienced in chamber group settings will coach trios, quartets, and quintets in this wonderful music form where compositions are performed by and written for one player for each part. Guest performers and speakers will share their experience in successful chamber music performance and ensemble development. Culminating presentation by all groups at the end of the camp.

String players need a developed vibrato. Students must be **at or beyond** the following representative minimum skill levels:

- VIOLIN:** Suzuki Book 4-Vivaldi a minor Concerto
- VIOLA:** Suzuki Book 4-Seitz Concerto #2, 3rd movement
- CELLO:** Suzuki Book 4-Breval Sonata in C Major
- PIANO:** Clementi or Kuhlau Sonatinas
