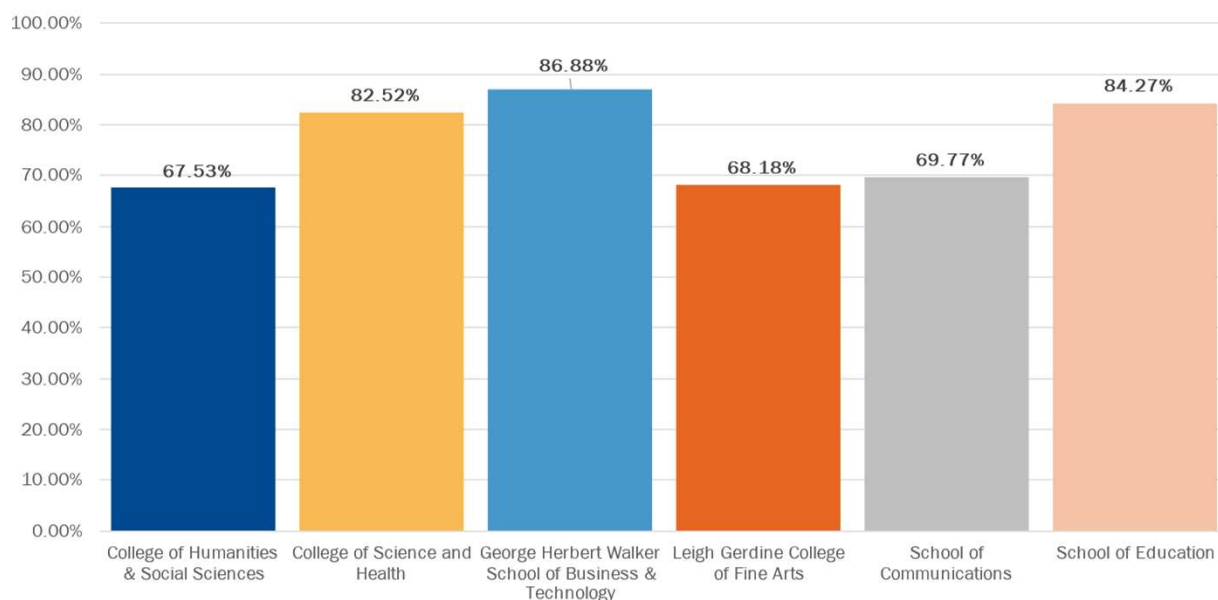

First Destination Outcomes - Breakdown

Out of 3285 graduates in 2022-2023, Webster obtained a knowledge rate of 26.73%. This knowledge rate is based on survey responses from our recent graduates as well as data gleaned from research done on LinkedIn. Of the students we have first destination knowledge of (26.73% of graduates in 2022-2023), 82.94% of these Webster graduates have gained employment or have been accepted into graduate or professional programs within 6 months of graduation.
