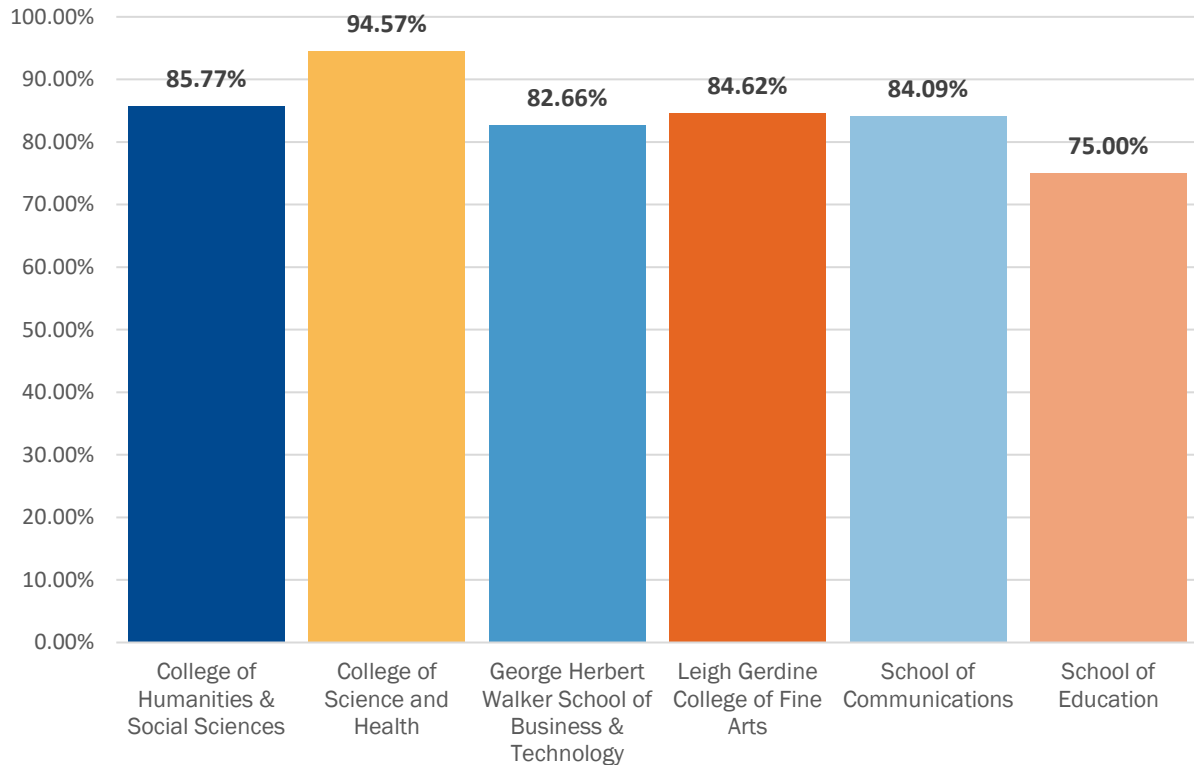

First Destination Outcomes - Breakdown

Out of 4799 graduates in 2024-2025, Webster obtained a knowledge rate of 28.51%. This knowledge rate is based on Outcomes Survey responses from our recent graduates as well as manual scrubbing of LinkedIn data. Of the students for which we have responses or found data, 80.7% of these Webster graduates have gained employment or have been accepted into graduate or professional programs within ~6 months of graduation.
