Out of 4506 graduates in 2018-2019, Webster obtained a knowledge rate of 53.08%. Of the students we have first destination knowledge of (53.08% of graduates in 2018-2019), 92.21% of these Webster graduates have gained employment or have been accepted into graduate or professional programs within 6 months of graduation.
