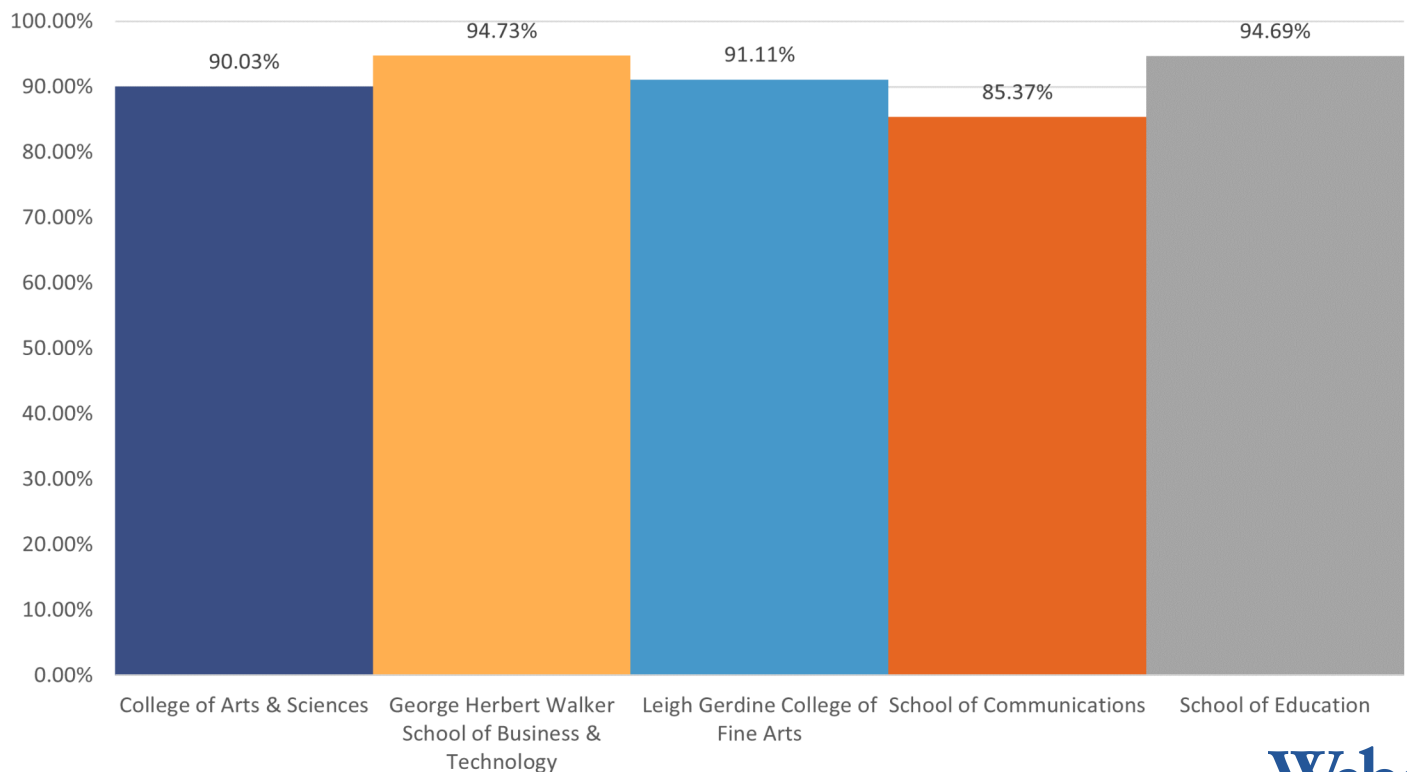

First Destination Outcomes - Breakdown

Student Outcome	Combined	Undergraduate	Graduate
Employed Full-Time	85.17%	62.88%	91.13%

Out of 4344 graduates in 2019-2020, Webster obtained a knowledge rate of 50.83%. This knowledge rate is based on survey responses from our recent graduates as well as data gleaned from research done on LinkedIn. Of the students we have first destination knowledge of (50.83% of graduates in 2019-2020), 93.32% of these Webster graduates have gained employment or have been accepted into graduate or professional programs within 6 months of graduation.
